Celebrating the blooming of cherry or sakura trees is a very important part of Japan's cultural tradition. The custom of viewing cherry flowers, called "hanami" in Japanese, draws multitudes of visitors in spring. Taiwan also boasts terrific cherry scenes.

From late January to March such spectacles appear over the island with such subspecies as mountain cherries, yae zakura and yoshino cherries in full bloom. They announce the advent of spring, a time of vigor and happiness.
